

Trauma NB Registry

The Trauma NB Registry houses data on all patients injured admitted to a level I, II, or III trauma centre with a Canadian Triage Acuity Score (CTAS) of 1 (resuscitation), 2 (emergent), or 3 (urgent). The registry also includes pediatric patients regardless of their CTAS and patient who died in the emergency department, but not patients who died on arrival to hospital or who died on scene of the injury. The registry includes injury severity scores (ISS) for qualifying patients, the standard metric to quantify “how injured” is a patient. Additionally, the registry includes operative, non-operative, and diagnosis codes, pre-hospital ambulance data, and a quality review of the care provided to each patient with risks of patient safety noted with quality filters.
